

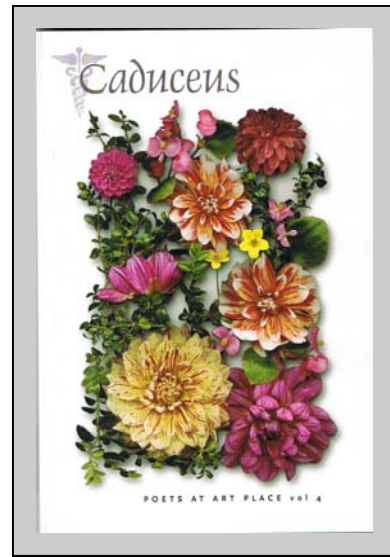


CADUCEUS

Guidelines



Caduceus, a collection of poetry, is accepting submissions for its sixth edition which will be published in November of 2008. The collection is sponsored by the Yale Medical Group and Art Place, and its publication will be celebrated with a reading at the Yale Physician's Building. The anthology will be available to patients visiting the building in the reception areas. The collection will have a medical emphasis, however all types and styles of work are sought.

Guidelines: Send up to 5 poems, one poem per page and no more than five pages typed on 8 1/2 x 11 paper. Author's name, address, and telephone number should appear on the top right of each page. **All poems must be the original work of the submitting author - no translations, no simultaneous submissions, previously published work considered with permission for reprinting.** Send a cover sheet with the title of poems submitted, contact information and a short biography.

Include SASE for notification. **No poems will be returned.** All submissions must contain a return address on outside envelope or they will not be opened. No electronic submissions.

Authors whose work is accepted will be asked to sign a publication agreement and to send a proofed copy on a floppy disk or electronically via email. Authors will receive one copy.
